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SECTION 1

The Molds

The mold is the pattern cast into the rim — the signature of a real clay chip and the first choice of any custom set. Sixteen designs in 39mm, two in 44mm oversize. Price tiers refer to the price list in Section 5. Crown molds, FDL, and 44mm A-Crest produce smooth inlays; all other molds texture the inlay to some degree.



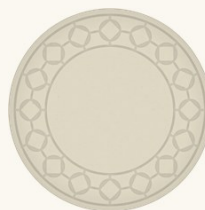

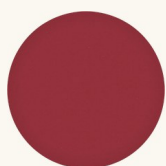
The Clay Colors

All 38 colors, mixed from scratch to formulas handed down since the 1960s. Weighted colors are weighted with fine brass powder — no lead. Renders are calibrated screen approximations; order the 38-color sample set to see them in hand.

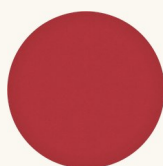

Bright White carries a premium as body or spot color — real clay can never be guaranteed free of impurities, and Bright White shows them most.

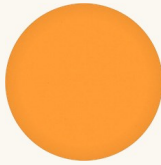

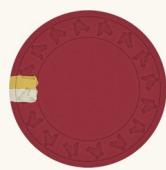
Every Edge-Spot Pattern

Edge spots are contrasting clay pressed into the rim — not painted, not printed. Every pattern below is shown on a red base with example spot colors; **any pattern can be pressed in any body and spot colors**. The level under each chip sets the price, shown as a range from the simplest coloring to the most complex — one spot color prices at the low end, and each added color moves a pattern up (double and split spots assume at least two colors). Solid through Level 5 is on the price grid; Levels 6–17 add a flat premium per chip. Pattern codes read count × width: “414” is four 1/4” spots, “312” three 1/2” spots; D = double, DS = split, A = alternating/offset, V = overlay, TA = stepped.

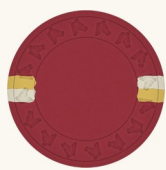

SECTION 4

Inlays

A printed inlay is protected by clear PVC vinyl and molded directly into the body of the chip — not a sticker. Circular inlays come in three sizes; seven die-cut shapes are available at a premium (shaped inlays cut at the 7/8" size). The Design Tool shows the exact printable area, bleed and punch line for every size and shape, and exports a print-ready proof.

SECTION 5

The 2026 Price List

Per-chip prices, 300-chip minimum. Three choices set the price: the mold group, the edge-spot level, and plain vs. inlaid — plus a few premiums. The Design Tool totals the price of a whole set as you build it.
